<b>Title I-A</b>	Helps low-income schools improve achievement of educationally disadvantaged students
<b>Title II</b>	Funds in-person tutors, as it is dedicated to strengthening “the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals, other school staff”
<b>Title III</b>	Supports tutoring with English learners and Immigrant Children and Youth
<b>Title IV-A</b>	Used to “provide all students with access to a well-rounded education, improve conditions for student learning, and improve use of technology to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy”
